Use this checklist as a guide to measuring the area.

Measure the height of the space under the counter. Be sure to measure in each corner.




Measure from the bottom of the countertop to the floor in front of the dishwasher. This will account for any new flooring that has been installed.

Do you have hard surface countertops like granite? These countertops need special installation procedures for the anti-tip brackets.

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Locate your breaker panel and identify the breaker for the dishwasher. The installer needs to turn off the power to your dishwasher during installation.

Locate the water shut-off valve.

In most cases, this is located under the sink and is attached to the hot water line of the faucet. This valve must be shut off prior to installation.







Per Minnesota state code, hammer arrestors are required for dishwasher installation. See your sales associate for full details and cost.
